Rotaract is a Rotary-sponsored service club for young men and women ages 18 to 30. Rotaract clubs are either community or university based and they are sponsored by a local Rotary club. This makes them true "partners in service " and key members of the family of Rotary. Rotaract Clubs' efforts begin at the local, grassroots level, with members addressing their communities' physical and social needs while promoting international understanding and peace through a framework of friendship and service. Rotaractors may: 1. Assist in organizing Interact clubs or mentor Interactors, 2. Participate in Rotary Youth Leadership Awards, 3. Become Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholars, 4. Seek membership in their local Rotary club. Rotaract Clubs may earn the Rotary International Presidential Citation by completing at least 4 of the requirements of the Citation.
